

Art Club – Visit to ArtScience Museum



It was an exciting interactive journey of exploration and play for 20 Art Club members at *Future World* - ArtScience Museum's 15 digital art installations come to life through cutting-edge science and technology (on April 29th 2016).

The adventure begins with an enchanting stroll through an interactive world of flora and fauna comprised entirely of digital technology, recreating the experience of being connected to nature. As visitors move through these galleries, they are invited to reflect on the intricate relationship they share with their environment.

A favourite among the members is the digitally rendered aquatic world where the two-dimensional sea creatures that visitors draw on paper come to life in a virtual ocean. The artwork grows and evolves constantly with the different images that the visitors add. The Art Club members had much fun feeding the fish and sea creatures by touching specific images of fish food bags on the screen. In *Sketch Aquarium*, student's creative processes become part of a unified, shared experience.

For most of the members, it was their first visit to the ArtScience Museum. They had seen that the boundaries between art and technology becoming increasingly blurred as new grounds are broken in digital artistic expression.
