

A Parent's Guide to KooBits

Introduction

KooBits ProblemSums is an online learning portal that aims to help your child master mathematical skills and fall in love with Maths all over again. At KooBits, we believe that in order to be good in Maths, your child needs to practice a bit of maths every day. Long term consistency trumps short term intensity. Thus, we designed the website to provide a winning routine for your child to follow. At the same time, we hope by spending time at KooBits, your child can develop a good learning habit over time.

How to use the following KooBits features for learning

Features	Description	How to monitor your child's activities
KooBits Challenge <i>(the most popular feature)</i>	<p><u>10 personalized questions</u> per day</p> <p>This set of questions are aligned with your child's class at school (choose <u>3-star difficulty level</u> to make sure it's in full alignment)</p> <p>If your child struggles with the questions, you can drop the difficulty level to 1-star or 2-star.</p>	<p>You can use the KooBits Weekly Planner (next page) to help your child keep track of his or her practice.</p>
Homework	<p>Your child's teach may assign e-learning homework from time to time. Go to "Homework" module to access the homework from your child's teacher.</p> <p>You, as a parent, can also assign homework to your child from the same Homework module – "Create New Homework". The recommended format is to have 5 questions per homework. Children are more receptive with byte-sized exercise.</p>	<p>You are encouraged to register "Homework alert" after you login to your child's account.</p> <p>It's under "Parent Register" at top right corner (click on your child's name to view the drop-down menu)</p> <p>Once you registered, you'll receive an email alert whenever your child's teacher assigns homework.</p>
Self-Practice	<p>Self-Practice module has all the questions from P1 to P6. Topics are linked on a knowledge map. Clicking on each topic will reveal all the skills, or specific instructional objectives.</p>	<p>You can monitor your child's proficiency for each skill. You can direct your child's practice to those weaker skills and topics.</p>
StoryMath, Brain Games	<p>Stories and games are activities that give children a different flavor of Maths. They present Maths concepts in an unique and interesting ways. They are unlocked by KoKo credits.</p>	<p>You can use stories and games as incentives for your child to practice maths questions. KoKo credits can be earned by completing homework and daily challenges.</p>
