To support and assess your child's/ward's learning, the following assessments will be conducted in Term 4 to provide feedback to you on his/her progress. The table on pages 2 and 3 indicates the days of the assessment together with the topics to be examined.

Please note the following guidelines pertaining to assessments:

- a. Students who are **unwell** on the days of examination are advised not to turn up in school. They should consult a doctor and obtain a **medical certificate**.
- b. The medical certificate should be submitted to the Form Teacher upon his/her return to school.
- c. A student with no medical certificate will be given zero marks for the assessment that he/she missed.
- d. There will be no make-up examinations for the absentees with the exception of Oral Examination.
- e. No extra time will be given for shading of Optical Answer Sheet (OAS).
- f. Marks for MCQ will depend solely on shading of Optical Answer Sheet (OAS).
- g. Latecomers who arrive more than 15 minutes from the start of the paper will not be allowed to take the paper. No marks will be awarded.
- h. There will be no extra time given to latecomers.
